

## You may be entitled to income tax refunds or other payments.

See the table below for the maximum amounts you may be entitled to (except for the solidarity tax credit, which are basic amounts) if you file a federal and provincial income tax return. Note that the amounts may vary depending on your situation and the cost of living index. Contact the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) and Revenu Québec for more information.
